

**PROCEEDING OF THE MEETING OF PUNJAB MEDICAL COUNCIL
HELD UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF PROF. MANMOHAN
SINGH PRESIDENT, PUNJAB MEDICAL COUNCIL WHICH WAS
HELD ON 16-04-2006 AT 2:30 PM**

The following agenda was discussed:

1. Confirmation of the proceeding of the Punjab Medical Council meeting held on 11-9-2005

The proceeding of the council meeting held on 11-9-2005 was unanimously confirmed.

2. Objectionable Advertisement Case- Affidavit Submit/ not submitted

It was decided that warning letters issued to the doctors be placed in the files of the doctors.

The doctors who have not submitted the affidavits be informed to do so within a fortnight. The action be initiated against the defaulters.

3. Medical Register/ Electoral Roll – election of the Punjab Medical Council under section 5 (1) (d.) (e) & (f)

The Registrar informed the Members of the Council that 35516 doctors are registered with the Punjab Medical Council upto 31-1-2006. The names of the doctors who have responded to the public notice upto 31-1-2006 have also been included in the Medical Register/ Electoral. At present out of 35516 doctors registered with the council the names of 13197 doctors have been updated. It was resolved that a Public Notice be given in the News Papers so that the doctors are made aware that their names will not be included in the Electoral Roll if they fail to update the names in the list maintained in the office of the Punjab medical Council.

4. Public Notice regarding claim/ objection of Electoral.

The draft Public Notice was approved with amendments. The Registrar will get it photaset from a professional. The same will be given in the news papers for the information of the Registered Medical Practitioners.

5. Complaint against Dr. Jayant Banerji alleged by J.S. Arora.

Sh. J.S. Arora and Dr. Jayant Banerji attended the council meeting. Sh. J.S. Arora submitted his statement along with an affidavit. The statement submitted by Adv. J.S. Arora was taken on record. Mr. Arora explained in detail the facts of the case to the Council Members.

Dr. Jayant Banerji also submitted the written statement. The statement was taken on record.

It was resolved that Mr. Kapoor be also called to ascertain the facts of the case. The Registrar will submit the details of the questions raised Mr. Arora in his complaint. Registrar will place the case in the agenda item for the next meeting.

6. Any other item with the permission of the chair.

a. Amendment to T.A. Rules.

The Registrar brought to the notice of the council that the Government of Punjab Department of Finance vide letter No. 18/12/2005-4FB2/ 868 dated 3-2-2006 has amended the TA/DA rules. The existing rate of road mileage per k.m. has been modified. The council unanimously decided to adopt the amended T.A. / D.A. rules.

b. Renumeration paid to Registrar

It was brought to the notice of the council that the renumeration paid to the Registrar is in lieu of expenditure incurred for usages of personal telephone and personal vehicle for official work of the council. The council unanimously approved that the renumeration paid to the Registrar is in lieu of expanses incurred on the usage of the telephone and vehicle for the official work. This renumeration is not a honorarium and should not be considered towards salary.

c. Shoor Hospital, Khazana Gate, Amritsar

It was brought in the notice of the Members of the council that an unauthorized hospital in the name of Shoor Hospital is running at Amritsar. It was resolved that an enquiry be conducted by the following team and will submit the report within 15 days.

The copy of the action taken report be sent to the Director General of Police; Secretary, Health & Family Welfare, Punjab; Director, Health Services, Punjab; Civil Surgeon, Punjab; S.S.P. Amritsar for information and necessary action.

d. Creation of post of Assistant Registrar Punjab Medical Council

The case was discussed in detail and the agenda item was deferred for consideration in the next meeting. The registrar will collect information from other councils whether such type of post exists. The qualifications, experience and eligibility conditions for the post be specified so that they are considered in the next meeting.

e. Term of elected members

It was informed that the elections to the three (3) posts of members Punjab Medical Council was conducted in the month of May. The government has extended the term of the council from two to three years. The council was constituted on the date when the notification of appointment of President was issued. So it was resolved that the term of the council had started from the date when the President was appointed. The Registrar is authorised to communicate with the Government accordingly.
