The council unanimously decided and adopted Punjab Government T.A./ D.A. Rules. The members are permitted to undertake the journey by road from the place of their residence to the venue of the meeting in their own car. The Registrar is empowered to sanction and pay T.A./ D.A. to the members of the council. This shall be applicable from the constitution of the council as per notification by the Punjab Government vide notification No. 13/5/2001/HBIII/ 5212 dated 3-11-2003.

Agenda Item No. 10

Renovation of office of the Punjab Medical Council: -

The council unanimously approved the action taken by the President and Registrar regarding payment and acquiring building on rent at Mohali. It is further resolved that the office of the President and Registrar be renovated. For this purpose the registrar is authorised to purchase sofa set, executive chair, visiting chair, vertical curtain and other official material from the market by inviting quotation from the market. The Members also resolved to have a separate cabin for the members to sit.

Agenda Item No. 15 (i)

The council approved and authorised registrar to get code of medical ethics printed from the market and the copy of distributed to all the Registered Medical Practitioners at the time of permanent registration at the cost of Rs. 100/- per copy w.e.f. 1-4-2004.

Agenda Item No. 15 (ii)

A few cases have been reported where the Doctors registered with the PMC at Ludhiana but there record is not available in the office of the council. They have in possession the Registration Certificate duly signed by the then Registrar. The council feels that there was no fault of the registered medical practitioners who have deposited their fees and got their registration certificate from Pt. Hans Raj Sharma, Registrar of the council, the record pertaining to which is not available in the council office. To regularize the registration of such type of registration the council approves that there should not be any penalty for fresh registration year wise. Only a one time penalty of Rs. 1000/- be levied for registration and such type of registered medical practitioners be registered as a fresh by depositing the registration fee alongwith penalty.

Agenda Item No. 15 (iii)

Complaints:-

The council approved the constitution of the enquiry committee to look into the complaints pending against registered medical practitioners. The disciplinary committee will establish the facts and will submit their recommendations to the Ethical Committee. On the recommendation of ethical and disciplinary committee the council will take appropriate action against the registered medical practitioners. The council further unanimously authorizes the President, Punjab Medical Council to constitute any other committee (ies), if so needed, for the smooth functioning of the council. The registrar will be ex-officio secretary of all the committee.

A complaint box with lock and key be placed at a suitable place in the office of the Registrar so that complaints of any nature can be put in the box. The box will be opened periodically in the presence of the President and suitable action be taken within a week. The keys of the complaint box shall be with the President. The complaint of any nature received in the office of the registrar shall be brought in the notice of the President as early as possible preferably within a week.

Chairman of two committees may co-opt eminent doctors in the committee with the approval of the President depending on the circumstances and the requirement on case-to-case basis. The action of the disciplinary and ethically committee will be advisory in nature and the council will be empowered to take appropriate action on the recommendation of the disciplinary and ethical committee. All correspondence on behalf of the council will be through the Registrar.

The Registrar is authorised to communicate with Home Secretary, Director General of Police, Secretary Consumer Courts to fix dates for the President meeting to discuss the cases of malpractice, misadventure and negligence. They will be requested to take the council in confidence before registering any FIR against the Registered Medical Practitioner.

The following committee is constituted for suggesting draft amendments in the act :-

They will prepare the draft amendments on the basis of Delhi Medical Council Act and other acts applicable in the other state. They will submit the draft amendments of the Act by 30th April, 2004.

Council approves the nominal application fee of Rs. 20/- per form w.e.f. 1-4-2004 (This amount shall be recovered/ Charged at the time of deposit of fee). However if practitioners download the performs from the website he has to add the price of the performa alongwith the registration fee.

The council authorised the registrar to take up the matter with the Govt. of Punjab for the extension of tenure from two to three year, as per section 7 of the act and approach the government to revise the notification under section 7 instead of section 5 of the Act.
