Through this public notice all the Doctors (Registered Medical Practitioners) Registered upto 31-7-2004 with the Punjab Medical Council (PMC) under PUNJAB MEDICAL REGISTRATION ACT 1916 are advised to immediately communicate to the Council by replying to this notice and providing full details in the Proforma format given below. Those possessing LMS qualification should also intimate whether they possess any other qualification listed in the 1st schedule of the IMC Act 1956 (Attach Proof)

Doctors practicing in Punjab but registered with Medical Council of India/State Medical Council of other states should also submit proof of their registration along with above proforma for office record.

Doctors already Registered with Punjab Medical Council are required to obtain Registration of their Higher/ Additional Qualifications under Section 26 of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956. Unless the Higher Qualifications are registered with PMC it is illegal for the Doctor to Practice in that Speciality / Super Speciality. To avoid any legal complications please get yourself Registered for Additional Qualification within 30 days of this Public Notice. Form for Registration of Additional Qualification can be had from the office of the Punjab Medical Council.

Attention of Registered Medical Practitioners are invited to Rule 7A of the Punjab Medical Registration Rules framed under Section 24 of the Punjab Medical Registration Act 1916 by which the Registrar is empowered to erase the name of the physician with whom he is unable to communication. The Relevant portions of the Act is reproduced below:

"The Registrar is empowered to erase from the Register, with written approval of the President, the name of any Registered person with whom he is unable to establish communication".

"Every Person Registered in the Medical Register shall notify any transfer of the place of his Residence or Practice to the Council within 30 days.

All Doctors are advised to submit the requisite information asked above within 30 days of the Publication of this notice failing which the name of the Doctor (Registered Medical Practitioner) is liable to be removed/ erased from the State Medical Register under Rule 7A. Doing Practice without valid Registration is an offence.

Attention is further drawn to the Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct/ Etiquette & Ethics) Regulation 2002 which has also been adopted by the Punjab Medical Council. A copy of this Regulation can be obtained from the Punjab Medical Council by sending Bank Draft of Rs. 100/- in favour of the Registrar, Punjab Medical Council, Payable at Mohali. All Doctors are advised to strictly adhere to the provisions of this Regulation in the best interest of the Patients & Profession. Violation of the Provisions of this Regulation will invite Disciplinary Action by the Punjab Medical Council.
