

# PUNJAB MEDICAL COUNCIL PUBLIC NOTICE

It is proposed to bring the Punjab Medical Register up-to-date. All the registered practitioners under Punjab Medical Registration Act, 1916 may please intimate to the undersigned within 30 days of publication of this notice, their correct address, registration number and qualification. Those possessing MBS qualification shall intimate whether they possess any other qualification listed in the 1st schedule of the IMC Act, 1956 and send the proof of the same. For the entry of Additional Qualification obtained after first registration under Section 28 of the IMC Act, 1956. Additional qualifications are required to be entered in the Medical Register for which form are available with the council. I have also to draw your attention to Rule 7A of the Punjab Medical Rule framed under Section 24 of the Punjab Medical Registration Act, 1916.

"The Registrar is empowered to erase from the register with the written approval of the President the name to any registered person with whom he is unable to establish communication."

Every person registered in the Medical Register shall notify any transfer of the place of his residence or practice to the Council within thirty days.

As provided in this rule your failure to reply to this notice will result in the removal of your name from the Punjab Medical Register. It is, therefore, important that you reply to this notice early and provide full detail in the proforma given below
